

# Understanding the Annual Performance Report (APR)

## What is GPRA?

The 21st Century Community Learning Centers (CCLC) program, like most programs funded federally, is subject to the **Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA)**. This Act dictates that metrics, referred to commonly as GPRA measures or “The GPRA” serve as program outcomes for the purpose of completing the required **Annual Performance Report (APR)** submitted to Congress. See below for a summary of the new GPRA measures.

### Data will be collected in the following categories:

#### **GPRA #1: Academic Achievement**

- Percentage of students in grades **4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup>** participating in 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC programming during the school year and summer who demonstrate growth in ELA on state assessments.
- Percentage of students in grades **4<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup>** participating in 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC programming during the school year and summer who demonstrate growth in mathematics on state assessments.

#### **GPRA #2: Academic Achievement**

- Percentage of students in grades **7<sup>th</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>** attending 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC programming during the school year and summer with a prior-year **unweighted\*** Grade Point Average (GPA) of less than 3.0 who demonstrated an improved GPA.

#### **GPRA #3: School Day Attendance**

- Percentage of students in grades **1<sup>st</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>** in the 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC programming in the school year and summer who had a school day attendance rate at or below 90% the prior year and demonstrated an improvement in attendance.

#### **GPRA #4: Behavior**

- Percentage of students in grades **1<sup>st</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup>** attending 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC programming during the school year and summer who experienced a decrease in in-school suspensions compared to the **previous school year**.

#### **GPRA #5: Student Engagement in Learning**

- Percentage of students in grades **1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup>** participating in 21<sup>st</sup> CCLC programming in the school year and summer who demonstrated an improvement in teacher reported (surveys) engagement in learning.

#### **Additions:**

#### **\*Unweighted:**

An unweighted GPA calculates your overall average grade out of 4.0 - with the grade for every course contributing the same amount to the average without regard to subject or the difficulty of the coursework.
